

**WARRANT
FOR THE SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
NOVEMBER 6, 2014
TOWN OF AQUINNAH
COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS**

To either of the Constables of the Town of Aquinnah:

GREETINGS:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Aquinnah who are qualified to vote in elections and town affairs to meet at the **Aquinnah Old Town Hall in said Town on the Sixth day of November 2014, at 7:00 PM**, then and there to act upon the articles of this Warrant.

**ARTICLE ONE
Board of Selectmen**

To see if the Town will vote to approve a sum of up to **\$2,500,000.00** (Two million five hundred thousand dollars) borrowing authorized by vote of the Martha's Vineyard Refuse Disposal and Resource Recovery District for the purpose of financing the cost of capital improvements toward the restructuring of traffic flow and residential drop off at the Edgartown Transfer Station, or take any action relative thereto.

**ARTICLE TWO
Department of Public Works**

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate the sum of **\$2,545.00** (Two thousand five hundred forty five dollars) for a prior year public restroom repair bill, and to transfer that amount from the Building & Grounds Stabilization Fund, or take any other action relative thereto. **(9/10ths VOTE REQUIRED)**

**ARTICLE THREE
Building Department**

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate from free cash the sum of **\$2,950.00** (Two thousand nine hundred fifty dollars) for prior years bills related to wiring inspections done by the Assistant Inspector of wires, or take any other action relative thereto. **(9/10ths VOTE REQUIRED)**

**ARTICLE FOUR
Board of Health**

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate from free cash the sum of **\$2,868.05** (Two thousand eight hundred sixty eight dollars and five cents) for a prior year refuse district bill, or take any other action relative thereto. **(9/10ths VOTE REQUIRED)**

**ARTICLE FIVE
Town Accountant**

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate from free cash the sum of **\$502.21** (Five hundred two dollars and twenty one cents) for a prior year fuel bill, or take any other action relative thereto. **(9/10ths VOTE REQUIRED)**

**ARTICLE SIX
Board of Selectmen**

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate the sum of Five Hundred and Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$590,000.00) to purchase two parcels of land, and all improvements thereon, located at 9 & 13 Aquinnah Circle (Map 6, Lots 25.1 & 25.2), consisting of approximately .37 acres, for the purposes, among other municipal uses, of open space & recreational use, including the costs related and incidental thereto, such as site work and surveying; and, further, to meet this appropriation, by authorizing the Town Treasurer, with the approval of the Board of Selectmen, to borrow the sum of \$290,000.00 under and pursuant to M.G.L. c. 44, § 7(3), or any other enabling authority, and by authorizing the Town Treasurer, with the approval of the Board of Selectmen, to borrow the sum of \$300,000.00 under and pursuant to M.G.L. c. 44B, § 11, and to issue bonds or notes of the Town thereof; and, finally, to authorize the Board of Selectmen to take other action necessary or convenient to carry out the project, including the execution of deed restrictions or covenants required by G. L. c. 44B, § 12(a), if necessary.


**ARTICLE SEVEN
Community Preservation Committee**

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate monies, from previously reserved Community Preservation revenues, for the undertaking of the following Community Housing and Open Space efforts, as recommended by the Community Preservation Committee:

\$5,000 (five thousand dollars) from the Community Preservation Open Space and Recreation Reserve for the repair and restoration of an existing stone wall directly behind Town Hall, including the addition of at least one traditional barway for purposes of public access to the Town Center property, and

\$20,000 (twenty thousand dollars) from the Community Preservation Community Housing Reserve for emergency restoration and extraordinary repairs to the Old Parsonage Building at #3 Church Street, for the purpose of preserving existing Affordable Housing opportunities in the Town of Aquinnah, or take any other action relative thereto.




